Your cover letter is the best way to introduce yourself to the hiring manager, expand upon experiences and skills listed in your resume and explain why you would be an asset to their company.

The **header** of your cover letter should include:

- Your information: name, address, email, phone number
- Today's date
- Company information: contact name, title, company name, company address

The **body** of your cover letter should include:

- Position you are applying for and how you heard about the position
- What distinguishes you from other candidates
- Specific references to the job description and your relevant experience
- Examples of your professional achievements and skills

The **conclusion** of your cover letter should include:

- A reference to why you are a strong candidate for the position
- The company's name
- A personal thank you for their consideration
- Your signature

It is with great enthusiasm that I am applying for the Second Grade Long Term Substitute Teacher position at Atkinson Elementary School that learned about through the School of Education and Social Policy at Merrimack College. For the last four years I have been a part of the North Andover and Merrimack Valley community as a student at Merrimack College and as a student teacher in many public schools. My strong desire to work with children and help them learn and develop, along with my enthusiasm for the teaching profession makes me an ideal candidate.

I did my full semester student teaching at the Tenney Grammar School in Methuen. Here, I was able to work alongside a dynamic teacher in an inclusive classroom and did a full classroom takeover. Working in an inclusive classroom allowed me to learn the different needs of students and adapt my teaching styles to fit the needs of all students. One student in particular who comes to mind had a one-on-one aide and really struggled with the math lessons. I worked very closely with the student and the aide to adapt planned lessons for this student to fully understand. Through constant communication and collaborations with the student and aide I was able to come up with a style that worked best for him. Over the course of the four months I was there, he improved his math grade by a full letter grade and it was a particularly rewarding experience, both for myself and the student.

Additionally, I did an internship through the Peabody Essex Museum summer camp program teaching art history to children ages 6-8. While there, I was able to develop my own curriculum and incorporate teaching strategies to help students get excited about art and learning at the museum. It was particularly challenging as students were on summer vacation and so their focus was of varying levels. I was able to incorporate interactive activities, current museum exhibits and games into the learning experience. This allowed students to continue to learn and grow, but still have a traditionally active summer experience. I also incorporated specific values into my approach and expectations with students. They are very similar to North Andover's "RAISE" values, with a specific focus on respect, inclusion, and empathy.

I look forward to continue promoting RAISE values as part of the North Andover Public School system and am excited to speak with you further about my experience, and I am excited about the opportunity to work with you and your students.
